

Advanced Project Management (Dip PM)

SUMMARY

Advanced Project Management is a 3-day workshop designed for project managers who aspire to manage large and complex projects. Typically, these projects are costly and organisationally critical.

Practicing project managers will acquire the knowledge and skills needed to effectively deliver projects on time, within budget, and with quality results as well as being able to contribute to planning and managing programs.

The workshop addresses the knowledge areas of PMBoK® and on successful completion, participants are eligible to be assessed for the Diploma of Project Management as well being able to apply for certification as Registered Project Managers (RPM).

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

Advanced Project Management is designed for practitioners with a minimum of 2 years project management experience. Participants should ideally have a Certificate IV in Project Management or equivalent experience and a working knowledge of PMBoK® or equivalent recognised standard.

QUALIFICATION PATHWAY

This course prepares participants to be assessed for the Diploma of Project Management (AQF: BSB 51504). The blueVisions AQF Assessment Program is designed to coach participants through the process of preparing a portfolio of evidence for assessment.

Participants are eligible to apply to apply for professional certification as a Certified Practising Project Manager (CPPM) with the Australian Institute of Project Management.

COURSE OUTLINE

- Manage project scope; conducting project authorisation activities, performing project scope definition activities and managing the application of scope controls
- Manage project time; determining and implementing the project schedule and assessing time management outcomes
- Manage project costs; determining, monitoring and controlling project costs and conducting financial project completion activities
- Manage project quality; establishing quality requirements, applying quality assurance processes and implementing project quality improvements
- Manage project human resources; planning and executing project team and stakeholder management and development activities and providing leadership within the project

- Manage project communications; planning communication processes, managing project information and assessing communications management outcomes
- Manage project risk; determining, analysing, and planning for project risks, monitoring and controlling project risks and assessing risk management outcomes
- Manage project procurement; determining procurement requirements, establishing agreed procurement practices, conducting and managing contract and procurement activities
- Manage application of project integrative processes; managing all project management functions, implementing project management activities through the project life cycle and coordinating internal (project) and external environments.
